HISTORY OF THE OSBORNES

James Osborne born in Warwick, England in 1674, and married Ann Carter of Strathord, England.

They had three sons and one daughter: Ephraim, Jonathan, William, and Frances.

Jonathan, son of James, was born in Warwick, England, March 27, 1697, and came to King and Queen County, Virginia, landing in the James River Settlement October 27, 1720. He married Grette Holman of Williamsbury in 1722. They had Ephraim, Jeremiah, Solomon, Josiah, and a daughter Johanna.

Jonathan was a member of the Colonial Assembly of Virginia in 1741-42.

In 1744 he joined the Kings Royal Guards and was in the Royal Service in New York and Port Royal in 1745-46.

Ephraim, son of Jonathan, was born near Williamsbury, August 23, 1723, and was a fur collector and service man in his early years, and in the service of Christopher Gist on the Yadkin River.

Ephraim married Betty Howard, a relative of Mrs. Gist in 1749 and settled north of the Yadkin River about ten miles from Mr. Gist the same year that Mr. Gist brought the Boone family to their first North Carolina home, when Daniel was about 13 years old.

Ephraim made his way to Snow Creek, Virginia, and to Starraton, Augusta County, Virginia, and visited the families of James Watson and George Gibson relatives in 1751.

About 1757 (some say 1761) he moved from Rowan County, North Carolina, to Grayson County, Virginia, and lived there until he died in 1796.

He and his son Jonathan were in the battle of Point Pleasant, in 1774 in Bland County, Virginia.

Ephraim and Elizabeth (Betty) had the following children: Enoch, Jonathan, Solomon, (who was killed by the Indians), George, Robert, Ephraim, Jr., John, Zachariah and one or two daughters.

Enoch was born in Rowan County, North Carolina about 1745, and died at Independence, Virginia, in 1818. According to records in the clerk's office at Independence, Mathew Dicky, and William Bowen, and Joe Fields and Joe Phipps were appointed in 1818 to value the personal estate and negroes of Enoch Osborne (Book 1, Page 173).

October 17, 1826, the estate was settled (Book 1, page 325). From "Annals of South West Virginia" we learn that Enoch Osborne served throughout the Revolutionary as Captain that on April 4, 1787, he was sworn in as Magistrate on May 3, 1789, was recommended to the governor as one of the Justices of the County. On April 7, 1782, the County reimbursed him for feeding the Soldiers that fought the Battle of Kings Mountain. On April 9, 1785, the Court approved orders given by Captain Enoch Osborne for Military supplies furnished during the Revolution.

Sarah married Scos Dixon.

Zachariah married Charity Reeves.

Knock, Jr., married Polly (last name not known).

Solomon was born near Dabgonnan, Virginia, December 1765 and died on Indian Creek, Pike County, Kentucky in 1831.

Solomon married Hannah Bowling daughter of Jesse Bowling of Salisbury, North Carolina, and they had the following children: Sherwood about 1788-1877, born 1790, died 1798, Dicks 1794, Solomon, Jr., 1796, born November 19, 1798--January 30, 1842, Hannah 1800.

Solomon and family moved from Scott County, Virginia to Pike County (then Floyd) Kentucky in 1805. When there were but five or four families between Jenkins and Wiggs.

They first settled at Elewicks Branch and stayed there two years. Then moved to Indian Creek when it was a wilderness. They lived 14 years on Indian Creek before there was a death in the neighborhood.

Sherwood, son of Solomon, married Lertisa Collier and they had Jerry, who served as Assessor and County Judge born 1814, died 1884, Steve 1818, Nina December 25, 1820, Zannah December 25, 1822, John Wesley 1824, Shade 1825 (died 1899), Neal December 27, 1828 (died August 12, 1909), Sally 1830, Dicy July 18, 1833, Danna 1835.

Jerry married Polly Moore November 17, 1836, and they had two daughters: Hulda and Rilda.

Rilda married George Francine, and they had Patty, Rev, Hulda, Harriet, Dora, Lewis, and Bryant.

Patty, daughter of Rilda, married Marion Hatliff and they had Judge Alex, Helen, America, Thaddeus, Jackson, William, Mark, and Harriet.

Hulda married Noah Potter and they had: Prof. George W, Seda, Frances, Lucrecia, Jailand and Clarence.

Dicie, daughter of Sherwood, married Rose Tackett April 17, 1831, (when she was 15).

Steve, son of Sherwood, married Nancy Mullins July 2, 1840, and they had two sons: Sherwood and Booker.

Mima married Rev. William McCown and they had: Martha (Mrs. Leon Kanna) James, Wes, Steve, Jane (Mrs. Jack Caudill), Nina (Mrs. Wes Adkins), Eoen, Tom, Will, Mary (Mrs. H. C. Akers).

Shade, son of Sherwood, married Betty Robertson, February 1, 1846, and they had: William, Alamander, Jeremiah, Albert, Lina (Mrs. A. J. Mullins), Lena (Mrs. Mannel Hall), Alice (Mrs. Dave Branham and George Hall), Sally (Mrs. Mat Damon), Louise (Mrs. Harve Tackett), Nancy (Mrs. Sol Tackett), Liz (Mrs. Mark Kinney), Will married Louise Little, Alamander married Arrina Hall, Vona, America and others. Jeremiah married Louise Keel, Albert (Bud) married Ruth Ray.

Sally, daughter of Sherwood, married William Tackett, January 22, 1846, and they had: Shade, Adaline (Mrs. Henry Ramey), Hance,

Sarah (Mrs. Jim Hudson and Clark Holbrook), Rhena (Mrs. Marshall Osborne), Lizzie (Mrs. Andy Johnson).

Benjamin, son of Solomon, married Sussanna Baker in 1813, and lived on Turkey Pen of Indian Creek till some of his children married (one married Isaac Mullins) and they moved to Dismal River, Virginia.

Anna, daughter of Solomon, married Euck Blankenship and they had: Barnet, Hannah (Mrs. Johnny Akers), Dacie (Mrs. Tom Riley), Vina (Mrs. Jack Bartley), Minna (Mrs. Allen Hall), Christine (Mrs. Will Reynolds), Bill and Mitch. Solomon, Jr. married Rachel Clark and moved back to Virginia. They had no children.
