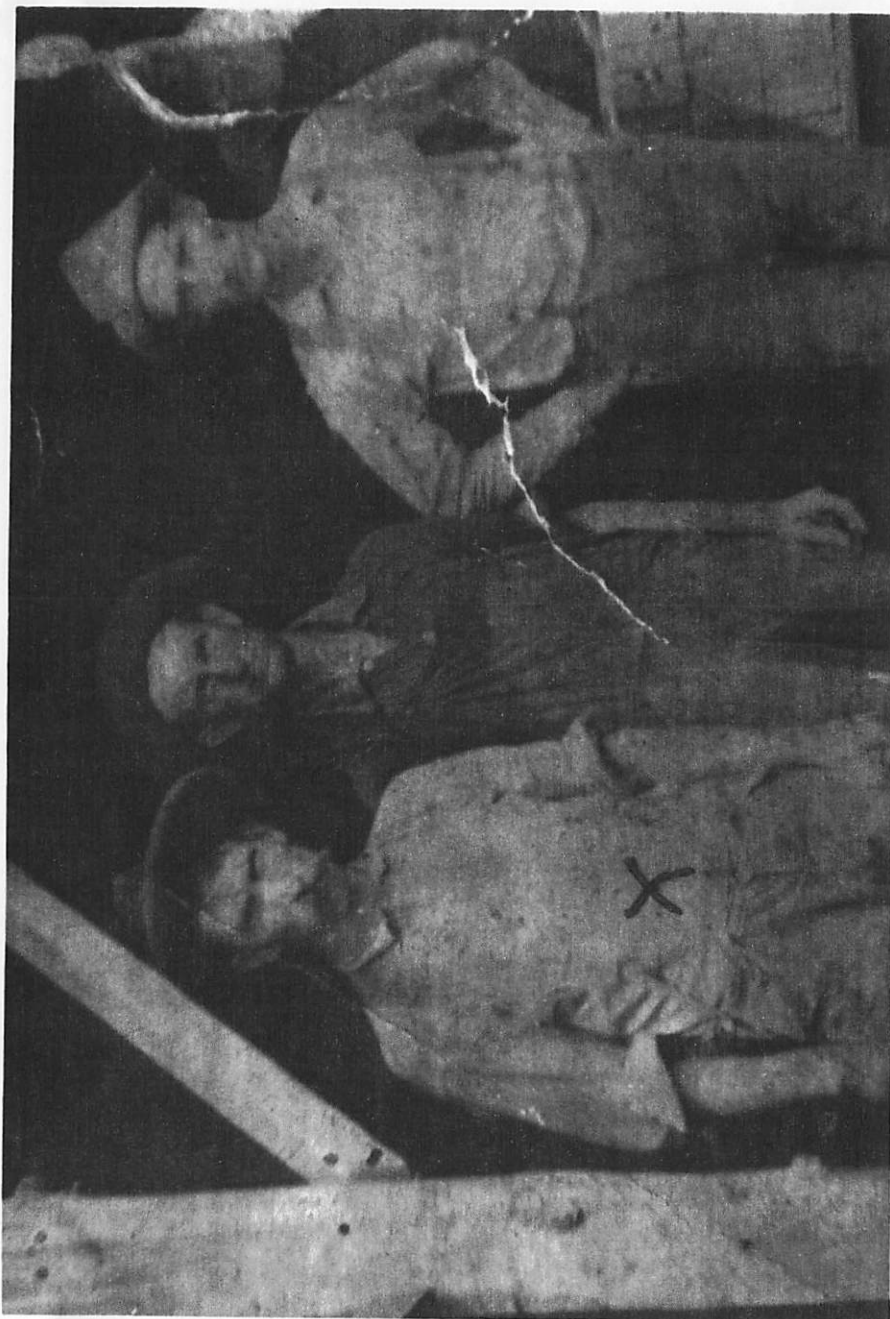

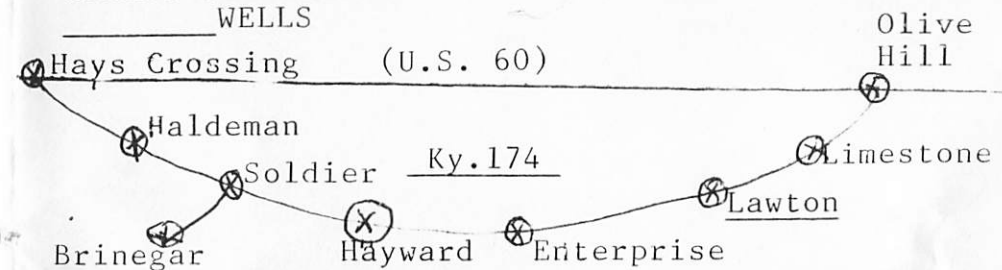

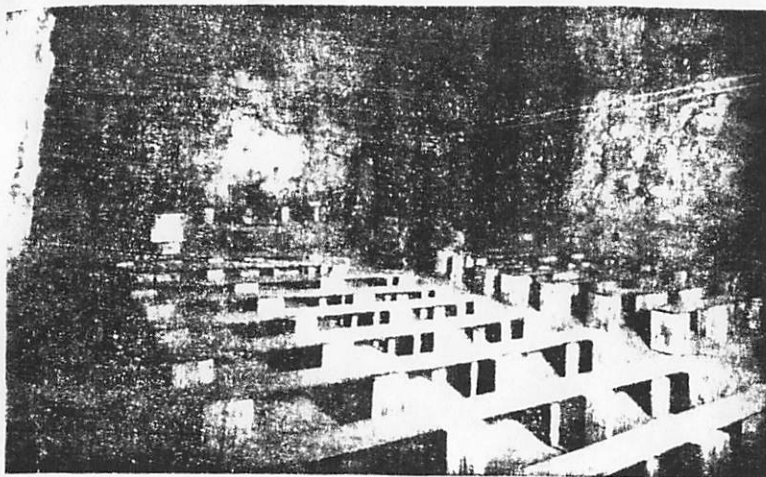

BIG STONE CHURCH

Lawton, Kentucky

THIS is one of the greatest wonders of its kind known to man. It is, strictly speaking, an underground Church, located in the center of a great rock formation in Carter County, four miles southeast of Olive Hill, Kentucky.

Mr. H. W. Hillman owns and operates one of the largest stone quarries in Eastern Kentucky. He is a member of the Methodist Episcopal Church of which I am a pastor. In the fall of 1931, he asked me to come and preach to his employees, as this community was very much in need of the gospel. I accepted the proposition. He located a place in the quarry, which was suitable for such services, and immediately began the work.

At once, Mr. Hillman began to set his house in order. A heating plant must first be installed. He drilled a hole through the top, in order that smoke might have a means of escape, making a pipe 124 feet high. Then he secured lumber and made seats to accommodate the people. He afterwards sealed all the entrances to this church, which made it very comfortable. A pulpit was erected and a stand was built from rock taken from the quarry. It is indeed, a most wonderful structure, and everybody who possibly can, should see it.

The hours of service is every Thursday morning from 10 to 11 o'clock. At this hour the machinery is stopped and all operations and business suspended. Then the men gather in the church for service.

with these good people, who hunger for the truth of God's word. As I have stood on the mountain side and watched the men, women and children coming from far and near—some in wagons, some on horses and mules, and some afoot—I have often experienced an ache of joy in my heart.

This church has personally cost Mr. Hillman a considerable outlay of money. He shouldered the burden with manly fortitude and genuine Christian grace. He has proved his faith by his works, and without any degree of ostentation. When pay day comes around, every employee is paid in full for the hour spent in the church service. Oh, how I wish that more business men—men who are financially able—would see the great need of their employees for the gospel, and extend to them a helping hand. If such a policy was generally adopted, soon the country would be swathed in sunshine instead of being enveloped in gloom.

Many persons have come from various states to see this great underground church. It is a marvel to all who see it.

I only wish that more men would follow Mr. Hillman in this great field of Christian service, and make a sacrifice to bring spiritual bread to the starving millions of our land, as well as material bread.

Even during these months of depression, this quarry has been working most of the time.
