There were two William H. Alfreys only two years apart in age in early Rowan County. One was the son of Alfred H. Alfrey & Mary Ann Bradshaw, the other was the son of Samuel Alfrey & Mary Ann Manley.

Morgan County Vital Statistics on LDS microfilm #0216835 list the birth of William H. Alfrey on 29 Aug 1855, birthplace North Fork Licking, to Alfred H. Alfrey and Mary (mother's maiden name illegible.)

Rowan Co. birth records, on LDS microfilm #0216839, list W. H. Alfrey, b. October 16, 1857, son of Samuel Alfrey & Mary A. Alfrey.

1860 census of Rowan Co., Ky, lists as family #260:
Samuel Alfrey, 23; Mary Ann, 20; William H., 2; Fielding, 3/12.

1860 census of Rowan Co., Ky, records as family #269:
A. H. Alfrey, 45; Mary A., 38; Caroline, 17; Bruce, 15; William H., 5; Alfred W., 1.

1880 census of Rowan Co., Ky, Licking City precinct, lists as family #181:
Samuel Alfrey, 43, farmer; Mary A., 39, wife; William H., 22, son;
Martha E., 15, dau; Sarah P., 13, dau; Allen, 11, son; Harvey, 5, son;
Elizabeth <illegible surname>, 64, boarder, widowed; Lucinda Reed, 60,
boarder, Rachel Ramey, 45, servant.

I can't find Alfred's son William in 1880, although if his middle name was Henry, he might be this family living two households after Alfred, and next door to Alfred's son R. Bruce Alfrey:

1880 census of Rowan Co., Ky, Pearce precinct, lists as family #240:
Henry Alfrey, 24, farmer; Vina, 20, wife; Farris, 3/12, son.

The only marriage record I can find in Rowan or Morgan county for a W. H. Alfrey is this one:

Rowan Co. marriage book A, p. 69:
W. H. Alfrey m. Josephine Myers on 15 Jun 1882

Marriage register book A does not list ages of bride and groom, nor parents (just the minister and where the marriage took place.)

My question is, which William H. Alfrey married Josephine Myers?

My best guess is that the Henry age 24 in 1880 with wife Vina is Alfred's son, that he married in 1878 or 1879 (Rowan Co marriage records for the 1870's were lost to fire), and that the W. H. Alfrey who married Josephine Myers was Samuel's son.

Does anybody have the 1900 census or soundex to check the age of Josephine's husband? Or have personal knowledge of either of these two families?
