
COLLINS FAMILY HISTORY

Our direct family line has been traced to Elijah Collins and Dorcus Nickel, married 12August1837 in Morgan County. She was the daughter of Andrew B. Nickel, (Black Andy), b. 11Januaryl 793, d. 14Mayl 879, and Elizabeth?. Elijah Collins appears in the 1840 United States Census but the 1850 census was the first to list any other than the head of household. 1850 finds Elijah and Dorcus in Morgan County with the following children and their ages; Elizabeth 13, Sidney 8, Pheba 5, John4, and Elijah2. 1860 Morgan County Census; Elizabeth is not listed so it is presumed that she married. There are three additional children; Franklin8, William6, George B.5. Franklin appeared in the vital statistics of Morgan County; Male, (not named), born on Little Sandy 30Aprill854. William was born in June of Sidney married Emanuel Cole, John married Lottie Stephens, Elijah Jr. married Susan Stephens d. 1874. 1870 Morgan County Census also lists three additional children; Henry 10, Louisa 5, Morgan 2. Elijah Collins died sometime between 1870 and 1880, because 1880 census finds Dorcus as the head of household with the following children remaining at home; Sidney Cole40, Elijah30 and Patrickl9 (Henry). William Collins married 23Febuary1886, Mary Jane Hall, b. in March of 1857, d.17Febuary1926. She was the daughter of Squire Hall and Nancy Talbert. 1880 Morgan County Census; William Collins27, Mary Jane23, with two children; Sena4, Squire2. There isn't any 1890 census (destroyed by fire), but 1900 Carter County Census lists William and Mary Jane with the following; Hattie b.1886, Dolly b. 1887, Martha b. 1893, Melvin b. 1895, Emma b. 1897, and George b. 1900. Their last child, Bessie, died an infant with measles. The 1910 Census finds William and Mary Jane in Floyd County living on the Mouth of Mud Creek. This is thought to be where Mary Jane grew up. William worked here making white oak spokes for wagon wheels. This was the sum of the household; Dolly, Melvin Emma, George, Hattie & James Stephens, and Martha & Benjamin Allen. and Mary Jane moved back to Carter County sometime between 1910 and 1915, because it is at this time (ca.1916) that Melvin was indicted on several minor charges in the Carter County Circuit Courts. Later in 1918 Melvin killed three men in Olive Hill and was sentenced to the electric chair at Eddyville State Pen. Shortly thereafter William and Mary Jane moved to Yolyn, West Virginia. Here he worked at a coal tiple, Yolyn being a mining camp. It is here that William and Mary Jane died.
