## *Shedding Light on the Day Cousins of Rowan County*

First, a clip from the *Big Sandy News*, abstracted from the September 2, 1886 issue by Cora Meek Newson, who published the book, *The Big Sandy News*:

**John C. Day** and his cousin, **Thomas Alle Day** of Rowan County, became involved in a difficulty a few days ago which resulted in the fatal wounding of the first named. Thomas got a pistol and escaped.

← TAKE OUT - ISN'T IN ARTICLE

Fred and I found out that all newspapers don't always report the same story. Differences can be rather substantial, depending upon the distance from the event and, often, the politics of the editor.

**John C. Day** - born December 8, 1858, Rowan County - killed August 30, 1886, Rowan County.. Son of Jedediah Day and Cynthia Fannin. John married Sarah Black 13Mar1884. John C. was sheriff (1882-1884) when the fight broke out at the election August 4, 1884. Had John's deputy, Sam Goodan, been elected, John would have served as *his* deputy for the length of his term. Kentucky law at the time did not allow sheriffs to succeed themselves. During the Courthouse lawn fight, John shot Adam Sizemore and wounded him. John was adjudged not guilty and released. ( John not found on 1880 census.)

**Thomas Allen Day**- born April 1864 - died 1921. Son of Phillip G. Day and Amanda Oxley. Married A. (Alice) E. Humphrey 8Mar1888, Rowan County. Thomas served as Chief of Police in Morehead during 1893. Phillip G. Day had a sister, Elizabeth, who married Isaac C. Day. Phillip G. and Elizabeth were the children of John W. Day, born Indiana, and Mary (Day) Day.

John C. was a cousin to Isaac's children through their father and Thomas A. was their cousin through their mother.

Thomas A. and his wife were in the 1900 Rowan County Census with James Oxley, age 4, and listed as nephew. James was the son of James R. Oxley, a brother to Amanda, Thomas' mother.

Jedediah, Isaac C. and Jilson Day were children of Jacob Day and Susannah Cogswell. **James William Day** was the son of Jilson and Elizabeth Setter. James William Day was christened Jilson Setters, the Blind Fiddler of Lost Hope Hollow, by Jean Thomas, and traveled to New York City and London where he preformed for the Queen. It is thought that he composed the Feud song. The song and a photo of Day are in the updated edition of *Days of Anger, Days of Tears*.

*This research is based on 1850-1900 census, Bibles and marriage records. I did not pursue all information, just what would prove relationships. I believe this clears up the mystery of the kinship of John C. and Thomas Allen Day. JB*

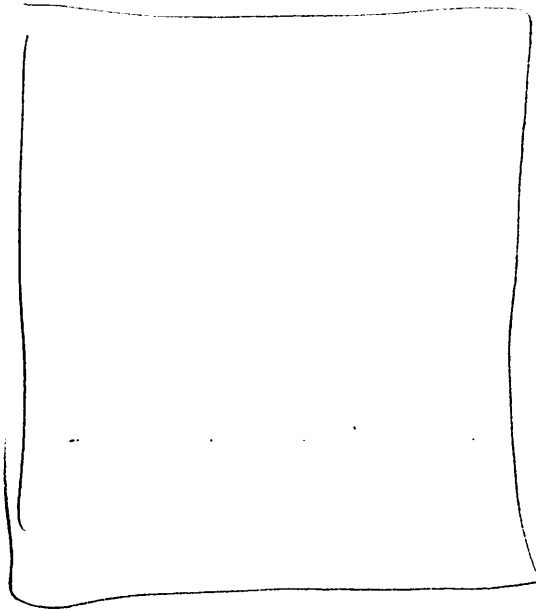

JOHN C. was supposedly killed by his cousin, Thomas Allen Day at Tom's Bar. John C. was Sheriff of Rowan Co. from 1882 to 1884 when W. Cook Humphrey was elected. This elected was on August 4, 1884. John C. married 13Mar1884 Sabie/Sarah Black. In the fight on Election day, John C. shot Adam Sizemore & injured him. No true bill was returned against John C. and he was released from Jail. From seaeching census records through 1900, I could find only one Thomas Allen Day. He was s/o Phillip G. Day & Amanda Oxley (no relation??). If the James A. Day is the Physician, he had a son, Allen T. who was 30 yrs. old in the 1880 Rowan Co. Census. This could have been John C.'s cousin, the name could have been changed by mistake. James A. was a brother to Jedediah (John C.'s uncle so his son would have been a cousin. Mabe that is the answer to all this, if it isn't then good luck finding the cousin.

The John Calvin Day born 1846 was still living in the 1900 Prec. #4, Hogtown Census and his occupation was listed as Mail Carrier.

(I have no connection with the characters in the Feud, only interested in the history of Rowan County. Speaking for Fred, I think his reason is same as mine.

DAVID "DAVE" DAY - Mar. 8, 1838. - Dec. 11, 1903. S/O Jedediah Day & Cynthia Fannin. Dave had 2 children by Mary Ann Brown (they never married). Willie was born Jan. 25, 1879, was killed at Neon, Ky. on June 10, 1914 and was buried there. Pearly Jane - May 13, 1882 - July 19, 1956. She married William Solomon Cox on 5Apr1900.

David married for the first time, Martha Ann Barker Cox. They had 1 Child, Susan, June 13, 1885 - Feb. 10, 1945. Susan married Allen Black and 3 children were born to this union.

In photo above Dave is pictured as right-handed - other photo of Dave & son, Willie Dave is seen as left-handed player. The negative of Dave must have been reversed when photo was printed. According to family members, Dave was left-handed. Dave's oldest brother, William, also played the fiddle.

Dave was a brother to John C. Day, who was killed by Thomas Allen Day, a cousin to John C., Dave & William. They were also cousins to James William (Jilson Setters) Day. (1st 2 paragraphs is information from Pearly Jane's Bible - 3rd para. is based on Census Records).

John Day applied for pension 11/4/1833, age 73. Born 6/28/1760, Ludenburg Co., Va, died July 16, 1837, Morgan Co., Ky. Enlisted Oct., 1776, Washington Co., Va. In his application for pension he stated that he knew Isaac McKenzie and served with him in North Carolina and Virginia.

John Day, born June 28, 1760 in Ludenburg Co., Va., died July 16, 1837 in Morgan Co., Ky. His mother was Susan Wylie Day. The family is of English extraction. John Day married Rebecca Howe on Sept. 10, 1782. She was born in Virginia Oct. 11, 1765 and died in Morgan Co., Ky., March 17, 1856.

John and Rebecca Day lived in Montgomery Co., Va. until 1810 when he moved to Morgan Co, Ky. on 200 acres of land that was granted to him for his services in the Rev. War. This land was located in the present County of Morgan near Caney Creek. All eight of their children married and settled in the localities of Caney Creek, Gillmore, Lacy Creek, Daysboro and Maytown.

THE DAY COUSINS OF ROWAN CO.

First a clip from "THE BIG SANDY NEWS" abstracted from the September 2, 1886 Issue done by Cora Meek Newson, who published the book, THE BIG SANDY NEWS .

JOHN C. DAY and his cousin, THOMAS ALLE DAY of Rowan County, became involved in a difficulty a few days ago which resulted in the fatal wounding of the first named. Thomas got pistol and escaped.

Fred and I found out that all newspapers don't always report the same story. There is always a difference somewhere in the same story reported in different papers.

John C. Day - b Dec. 8, 1858, Rowan County - killed Aug. 30, 1886, Rowan Co. Son of Jedediah Day and Cynthia Fannin and on 13Mar1884 John married Sarah Black. John C. was acting Sheriff, 1882 to 1884 when the fight broke out in Aug. 4, 1884. John shot Adam Sizemore and wounded him. John was adjudged not guilty and released. (never found John in the 1880 Census).

Thomas Allen Day - April 1864 - died 1921. Son of Phillip G. Day and Amanda Oxley and married A. (Alice) E. Humphrey on 8Mar1888, Rowan County. Thomas was Chief of Police, Morehead during 1893. Phillip G. Day had a sister, Elizabeth, who married Isaac C. Day.

John C. was a cousin to Isaac's children through their father and Thomas A. was their cousin through their mother.

Thomas A. and his wife were in the 1900 Rowan County Census with James Oxley, age 4, and listed as nephew. James was son of James R. Oxley, a brother to Amanda, Thomas' mother.

Phillip G. and Elizabeth were the children of John W. Day, born Ind. and Mary (Day Day).

Jedediah, Isaac C., and Jilson Day were children of Jacob Day and Susannah Cogswell. James William Day was son of Jilson and Elizabeth Setter. J. William was named Jilson Setters as his stage name (fiddle player, his photo is in the updated edition of DAYS OF ANGER, DAYS OF TEARS) It was thought that Jilson Setters composed the Feud song.

This research is based on 1850 - 1900 Census, Bibles and marriages to prove relationships. I did not persue all information, just what would prove this. I believe this has cleared up the case of who Thomas Allen Day was and how he was a cousin to John C.

# The Day Cousins

The following was taken from Bible Records, Census Records and Marriages, to show the relationship of two men, John C. Day and Thomas Allen Day.

John C. Day was born Dec. 8, 1858 and killed Aug. 30, 1886. John C. was son of Jedediah Day and Cynthia Fannin. John C. married Sarah Slack on 13 Mar 1884.

John C.'s uncle, Isaac C. Day, married Elizabeth (Day) Day, daughter of John W. Day and Mary (Day) Day. John C. was Sheriff of Rowan Co., 1882 to 1884.

Elizabeth, among other children, had a brother, Phillip H. Day. Phillip H. married Amanda Oxley, daughter of Isabelle (nee) Oxley and Prior Oxley. Phillip H. and Amanda had 6 children, the oldest being a son, Thomas Allen Day. Thomas A. was born April 1864 - died in 1921. He married A. (Alice) E. Humphrey on 8 Apr 1888. He was Chief of Morehead Police during 1893. I found him in 1900 Rowan Co. Census. Living in the household was James Oxley, age 4, listed as nephew. James was son of Amanda Oxley Day's brother, James R. Oxley and Matilda Waddle/Waddel.

John C. was cousin of his Uncle Isaac's children and Thomas Allen was also cousin to these children of Isaac's through his father's, Phillip G. Day's sister, Elizabeth, Isaac's wife.

John C. Day and his cousin Thomas Day of Rowan County became involved in a difficulty a few days ago which resulted in the fatal wounding of the first named. Thomas got pistol and escaped,

John C. Day - born Dec. 8, 1858 - killed August 30, 1886. Son of Jedediah Day and Cynthia Fanning. Married Sarah Black on 13 MAR 1884. John C. was acting Sheriff, 1882-1884. When the fight broke out in August the 4th, 1884, he shot Adam Sigamore and wounded him. He was adjudged not guilty and set free. (He was not in the 1880 Rowan Co. Census - where was he?)

Thomas Allen Day - ca April 1864 - died 1921. Son of Phillip H. Day and Amanda Oxley. Thomas A. married 8 APR 1885 Rebecca E. Humphrey. He was Chief of Police, Morehead during 1893. Phillip H. Day had a sister, Elizabeth, who married Isaac C. Day, a brother to Jedediah Day.

John C. was cousin to Isaac's children through his father - Thomas Allen was cousin to Isaac's children through his Aunt Elizabeth (Isaac C. Day's wife).

This is compiled based on 1850 census thru 1900 census, Bibles and marriages to show the line of relationships.

Jedediah, Isaac C., and Gilson Day were brothers. Gilson and Elizabeth Setter Day were the parents of James William Day, alias Gilson Setters, who may have written the Ballad of the Rowan County Fends. (His picture is in the book "DAYS OF ANGER, DAYS OF TEARS")
